Serbian economy has gone through a difficult transition period, and as a result of the transition a new ownership structure of the companies was obtained, a changed economic structure (development of the real sector of the economy neglected), as well as uneven investments compared to the previous allocation of economic capacities. This has contributed to

been revitalized in all parts of Vojvodina equally, which has led to imperishment of the population and demographic emptying of some part On the other hand, the concentration of economic activities in one of territorial poles (in the South-Bačka area) widens the gap between regions and creates preconditions for further strengthening of econo ic disparities in Vojvodina.
